PROVIDENCE PRIMITIVE BAPTIST CHURCH

History of Providence Primitive Baptist Church at Michie, Tennessee, written 1995:

On Saturday before the fourth Sunday in July 1889, a group of people who believed in the doctrine of sovereign grace, election, predestination and the effectual calling of all the redeemed for whom Christ died, assembled at Concord Church, Gravelhill, Tennessee. The group was duly and scripturally constituted into a church as the arm of Concord Church.

After being organized, Elder S. W. Lee was called their pastor and J. W. Braddy was elected as the church clerk. It was agreed that the church should be known as Providence Old School or Primitive Baptist and was located in Hardin County. (Exact site unknown)

On August 8, 1904, D. W. Reed and wife, N. E. Reed made a deed to Providence Primitive Baptist church of one acre of land for the purpose of relocating and building a church at what is now Michie, Tennessee in McNairy County.

The first building was a one room frame structure on (what is now) Highway 22, across from the C. W. Moore property. In later years it was remodeled, bricked veneered, adding rest rooms and baptistry. Through the efforts of Elder Wiley Flanagan, the co-pastor, a fellowship hall was added.

Pastors included the following Elders: S. W. Lee, N. V. Parker, J. A. Miller, J. W. Hardwick, E. D. McCutcheon, Wiley Flanagan and present pastor Ben Burcham.

Members who served as church clerks were: J. W. Braddy, Dr. B. W. Williams, J. N. Weatherford, J. E. Leath, C. P. Marler, W. L. Rushing, A. W. DeBerry and present clerk Larry DeBerry.

Among those who served as deacons were: I. R. Bradshaw, Dr. B. W. Williams, J. A. Farris, W. T. Gooch, W. H. Emmons, A. H. Rickman, Cecil Ernest, Herbert Cunningham and present deacon, A. W. DeBerry.

First recorded meeting at Michie Church was August 24, 1906. The Church has been at this same location for almost ninety years, still contending for the faith once delivered unto the saints. By Mittie Gooch Atkins, Dec 1995.

CONSTITUTION

On Saturday before 4th Sunday in July, A.D. 1889, we the following brethren and sisters believing in:

the vital union of Christ and the Church,
the Doctrine of Election, Predestination,
effectual calling of all the redeemed for whom Christ died
one only true and living God,
the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and that the three are one,
also in the perseveration of the Saints unto Glory,
the Resurrection of the dead and General Judgment,

were duly and scripturally constituted into a Church by Elders S. W. Lee and J. L. Grinthry as presbytery in connection with the arm of Concord Church, consisting of the arm from Concord Church, and after being organized called Elder S. W. Lee as their own pastor.

Granted Sister Leath a letter in full fellowship. Sister Mary Counts was baptized on Sunday, September 28, 1902. Closed in order.
